SPECIFIC EVENT CONDITIONS

The **Amazigh Raid** is an event inspired by the *Amazigh* people, their customs and resilience. We want to conquer breathtaking landscapes against the backdrop of the ancient mountains we will cross, enjoy challenging tracks in endless deserts, explore villages and their cultural richness and, above all, live a unique experience that combines the adrenaline of driving with conquering the most challenging tracks.

We'll start this journey in **Meknès**, where we'll have the event check-in desk and a welcome dinner. Here we'll spend the night and then set off on stage 1 to **Bin El Widiene, Morocco, on the 2nd of May**. This year's track will take you through Zagora, Tata, Ouarzazate, a night in the bivouac in Chegaga, and a fun different night out in Marrakesh. The last stage ends at the same place of departure, where we'll have dinner and spend the night, thus concluding the event. We'll return to Tarifa the following morning to mark our return to Europe on the morning of the 9th May.

NAVIGATION

Navigation will be carried out using GPS equipment (for reading tracks and waypoints) that can read files in **.gpx format**.

Whenever there are challenging sections on the main track, there will always be an easier alternative available to choose from. This will be clearly marked on the day's GPS track. With the exception to the day where we sleep in the Bivouac tents, there will always be a tarmac liaison to the next location where we sleep.

There will also be the opportunity to navigate via CAP, on specific days that the organization determine, adding to the challenge of this event

THE ROUTE

The route was designed to be accessible for all abilities of each participant. However, there will be some routes that are more demanding than others, and alternatives for those who don't want to take risks are available and marked.

The route was developed taking into account the gradual transition to stages with more offroad terrain, with the beginning and end always having a more road-based component.

SAFETY – S.O.S.

All motorcycles will be equipped with GPS tracking, position location and emergency call out, that will be handed out by the organization at the Admin Checks.*

MEDICAL TEAM

An experienced and qualified team will accompany the event in an off-road ambulance and a 4x4 vehicle.

XC ACADEMY

Longitude Experiences has and will prepare off-road / cross-country driving training courses to enable all participants who want to evolve. The prices of these training courses can be consulted on our website.

TYPE OF MOTORBIKE

All Off-Road capable bikes are permitted but must have a **minimum range of 200Kms**.

All bikes/riders must:

- Have a valid driving license for the category of motorbike;
- Civil liability and travel assistance insurance for the motorbike, valid for Portugal, Spain and Morocco (note: check the Morocco extension (MA) on the green card);
- Be in good general working order;
- Navigation system compatible with .gpx;
- Comply with all mandatory safety elements for riding on public roads (number plate, front, rear and brake lights, indicators and rear-view mirror)

ACCOMMODATION

The hotels where we will have dinner/evening at the end of each stage are all top quality 4 or 5 star hotels/riads. There will be also a night camping in the desert.**

FERRY

Ferry tickets from Tarifa / Tangier on 01/06/2026 and Tangier / Tarifa on 09/06/2026 are included.

For the participants that would like to make the crossing and customs passage with one of our Staff, easing the bureaucratic process to and from Marrocco, please let us know. (*This member of staff will only make the crossing to and from Marrocco once, so you will be obliged to accompany him if you need any assistance – the respective timetables will be published nearer the event date****)

CAR, VAN AND TRAILER PARKING

At the location of our first stay, which is the same place as the Admin Checks, there is a large capacity tarmacked parking lot, where you will be able to park your car/van, and also leave your trailers.

Naturally, we recommend that you leave your trailers chained and your cars and vans parked correctly, so that you can fully enjoy this event.

LUGGAGE TRANSPORT

The organizers will supply each participant with a plastic storage container (Approx 60lts) where all the respective gear needed for the duration of the event should be packed.

This container will be collected at the Admin Check in Meknès, or at Longitude Experiences location, during the week prior to the event.

During the event, these will be collected each day, BEFORE breakfast and transported to the next sleeping location.

On the last day of the event, the container will be handed to the participant, or can be transported in the organizers van to their location.

FOOD

All the dinners at the hotels where we will be sleeping are included in the registration. (Except drinks). On the days where there is no alternative during the track to buy lunch, the organization will hand out Lunch-Packs to all participants in the morning before the departure.

MECHANICAL / MEDIA TEAM

There will be a total of 4 dedicated team of mechanics that will participate in a 4x4 vehicle plus 1 motorbike, accompanying the group throughout all the stages. Likewise, there will be a media team dedicated to HD photo and video content delivered free of charge to all participants in the event.

RIDER EQUIPMENT

All riders have to/must wear:

mandatory	Off-road / rally-raid helmet or full-face helmet. Participants wearing modular or jet helmets will not be admitted;
mandatory	Body armour or airbag system to protect the torso, back, shoulders and elbows. Level 2 recommended or OffRoad Airbag jackets
mandatory	Enduro / adventure boots;
mandatory	adventure / off-road gloves required;
mandatory	Off-road trousers, knee protectors and hip protectors;
mandatory	Backpack / Camelbak® with at least 2 litres of hydration;
recommended	Soft-shell jacket / windbreaker;
recommended	<i>Neck-brace;</i>
recommended	Off-road jersey;

MOTORBIKE EQUIPMENT

All riders should have the following for their motorbikes:

- New off-road tyres;
- Have a puncture kit according to the type of tyre used (inner tube, studs or tubeless fluid);
- Engine protections;
- Crash bars;
- Hand guards;
- Extra levers;
- Extra Inner tube / extra patch kit;
- Extra air filters / pre-filters;
- Luggage for carrying the lunch pack / water / accessories with a recommended capacity of 6 to 12 litres.

INSURANCE

It will be mandatory to present (send policy + receipt) **personal travel and assistance insurance**, covering **repatriation and participation in non-competitive two-wheeled events**. We also recommend that **trip cancellation** be included if necessary, on an individual basis. PASSPORT REQUIREMENTS

Valid for at least **6 months** from the start of the event.

REGISTRATRION

Registration begins on 26/09/2024 and ends on 24/01/2025 and is limited. The capacity of the organisation and the venues where we will be staying result in a limitation in terms of capacity.

PRICE

2.750€ pax on a shared double bedroom

+475€ pax single room supplement

PAYMENT TERMS

Payment can be made in full at the time of enrolment **or** in 2 instalments of 50% at the time of enrolment and the remaining 50% by 02/02/2026. If the registration is not paid (fully or partially) after the first 5 days post registration, it will be considered annulled.

EXCLUSION

Longitude Experiences reserves the right to not accept registrations or exclude any participant who does not comply with the requirements of the event's specific conditions / general conditions, the recommendations of an organiser during the event or who threat the safety of himself / other participants.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Cancellations made until the 1st of November 2025, will be entitled to a 100% refund.

Cancellations up to 90 days before the start of the event (01/02/2026) will incur a penalty of 50% of the total registration fee, according to your sleeping requirements.

After 02/02/2026, no refund will be given. However, for both situations, we will endeavour to exchange the registration fee with a new participant via a waiting list of participants, thus speeding up the refund of the amount paid.

Longitude Experiences reserves the right to cancel, alter or interrupt the event when, for any reason, the safety or comfort of the participants is not guaranteed in the locations / regions of the event, including causes of force majeure.

In case of cancellation after the 02/02/2026, the organizers, whenever possible, will try and liaise with riders on the waiting list, to transfer the registration.

NOT INCLUDED

Everything not expressly defined as included will be considered as not included. Drinks at dinner, fuel, motorbike and rider travel, extra nights, flights, visas, travel insurance, excesses, personal expenses and the Lunch-Packs, among other examples.

REMARKS

Motorbikes in the name of / owned by a company require an authorization from the company, signed by the powers that be, stating that the person / rider is authorized to drive and take the motorbike to Morocco for a certain period. This document must be on company letterhead, written in your local language and translated into French or local language translated into English and be recognised by a notary or lawyer, provided it has a white seal.

The organizers can send you a proforma form so that you can adapt it to your needs

In case of accident/health problems or motorcycle breakdown, it is the responsibility of the participant to activate the necessary means to be transferred. However, the organization will naturally help and try and facilitate wherever possible.

* the tracking systems and S.O.S. are included in the event, however they must be returned in the same condition as they were given. In the event of damage, our partner will charge us a fee associated with the type of damage. There are 4 types of damage/deterioration, per level:

Deterioration	Code	Description	Amount to pay
Level 1	Yellow	normal use, small scratches, no deterioration;	0,00€
Level 2	Orange	deep scratches without damaged or broken rubbers/plastics;	30,00€
Level 3	Red	Deformation in the rubbers / plastics still functional;	75,00€
Level 4	Black	Misuse, structural damage that does not allow it to function again;	150,00€

This fee, if levied, will be charged in full to the participant in question.

**the desert camp has a maximum number of tents, which may depend on the number of participants in the 'single room' regime. Once the maximum capacity has been reached, we will inform you that only the shared room option will be available, or even, for the night of the camp only, shared camping, reducing the price by €50.00 for the single supplement.

*** there may be changes to the scheduled ferry crossings due to adverse weather conditions that affect the time/date/place of departure.
